Summary and objective:

The main objective of this task was to provide teaching staff from Montenegro and Albania with additional knowledge with research on the impact of pollutants in the marine environment. The training was entitled “Emerging pollutants in the marine environment: contribution of maritime transport activity” and was developed by Laura Martín from University of Cadiz (Spain).
