Dear partners,

I have just received a response from the EACEA regarding our request for a one-year project extension. Their decision is to grant a 7-month extension. Given that we cannot commence the joint master program before October 2024, it is apparent that we will be unable to complete the main output within the project's designated timeline. This decision surprises me, as in previous Erasmus+ CBHE projects, the EACEA has allowed for a one-year extension if the main output was not achieved. Now, we must consider alternative options in alignment with Montenegrin and Albanian legislative requirements.

Once I receive feedback on potential alternative commencement dates for the joint master program and the potential consequences if we do not initiate it within the project's lifespan, I will schedule an online PMB meeting, ensuring it takes place no later than October 27th.


