REPORT ON THE MEETING

Official opening

University of Ljubljana has expertise in distance learning technology and teaching methodology within MEP&M project. At first, the role of the University of Ljubljana team is to suggest adequate DL technology that PC HEIs should install at their premises and later on to provide know-how transfer of usage of such high end technology.

This was first meeting related to WP3 DEV 3.1. An idea was to get insight of DL technology that University of Ljubljana is implementing for their purposes. For the University, its Faculty of electrical engineering is in charge of providing, maintenance and trainings for DL technology and online teaching methodology.

Four persons attended meeting. From the side of the coordinating institution prof. Danilo Nikolic and Miodrag Zarubica, an IT expert, and from side of University of Ljubljana Marko Papić and Anže Zdravc who are their experts for Distance Learning.

WP3 – Capacity building through staff training and equipment purchase.

Regarding the activities on the WP3, the focus of the meeting was to consider the DEV.3.1 Procurement of equipment and e-books for supporting distance learning in MSc MEP&M. Hosts presented their DL technology systems that whole University of Ljubljana is using. They presented general ideas what would be the best technology solution for PC HEIs having on mind that for PC HEIs that would be something completely new and it could take time to learn how to adequately use it for some of staff. Also, issues related to interrupted logistics and production of some of DL equipment during COVID19 are to be considered.

At the end of the first meeting day participants visited premises of the Faculty of Electrical engineering in Ljubljana.


