Basic steps

- To make a plan (prepare and implement dissemination & exploitation) strategy)
- To create a content (prepare promotional products and materials leaflet, banner, stickers, poster, roll up, bags, pencils, etc.)
- To send a message to the stakeholders and wider public (establish web site of the project and social media accounts, agree on roles and responsibilities, involve all project participants, publish all project information even through existing channels of the institution)
- To communicate and interact (organize dissemination and exploitation events, arrange media coverage, write some articles, inter project coaching)
- To evaluate (measure project impacts, use SMART indicators, assess and improve).
